Social Workers can provide counselling for any child or family – individually, to couples or to the family as a whole. Social Workers also offer parent and child educational and support groups. - Advocacy skills development

- Self-esteem issues
- Family concerns
- Social isolation

- Sibling issues
- Abuse
