Game board

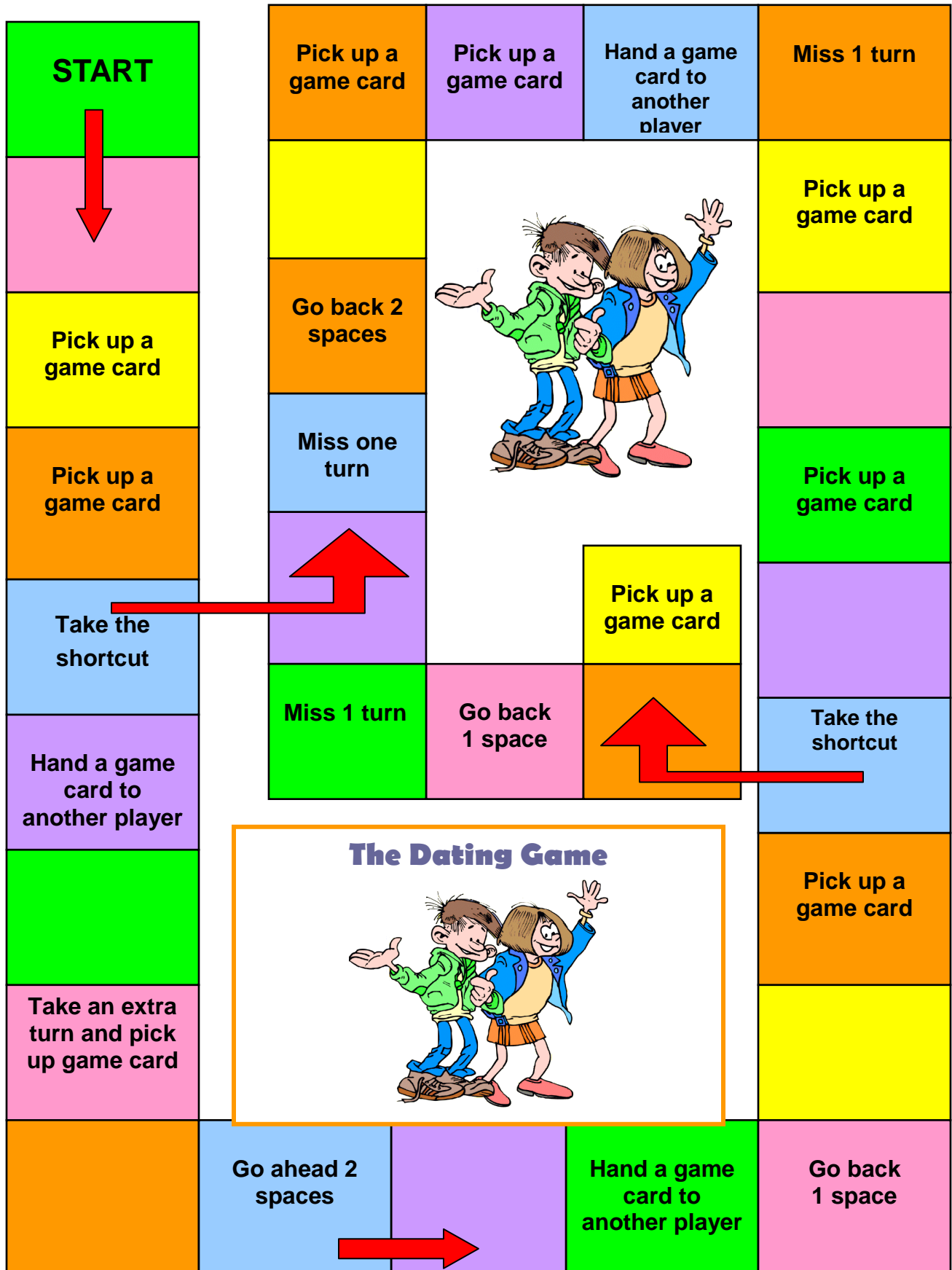
How to Play the Game:

Board Game Role Play: The Dating Game

How would you let a boy or girl know that you enjoy their company before asking them out on a date?	Role Play: Choose a partner and make small talk about a topic of <i>their</i> choice
Give a compliment to the person sitting to your left.	How do you know when someone wants to kiss you?
Role Play: Invite someone from the group to the movies.	Why is it important to be an “active listener” when you are on a date with another person?
Initiate a conversation with the person sitting to your right.	Talk about some strategies you can use when you start to feel anxious.
Give an example of a high risk or “red light” situation.	Name a place that you think would be a good choice for a first date.

<p>Role Play:</p> <p>You have asked someone out on a date and they said “No thanks, I don’t want to go out with you”. How would you react?</p>	<p>What steps would you take to get ready before going out on a date?</p>
<p>Tell the group one thing that you like about yourself.</p>	<p>Find out from the person beside you what <i>their</i> idea of a great first date would be.</p>
<p>Give some examples of appropriate conversation topics for a first date.</p>	<p>List some of the things that you are really good at.</p>
<p>Role Play:</p> <p>You are out on a date and your partner does not want to see the same movie that you would like to see.</p>	<p>Turn to someone in the group and finish this statement:</p> <p>“I like you because...”</p>
<p>Role Play:</p> <p>It is the end of the evening after a great first date, you would like to ask your partner to go out with you again.</p>	<p>Finish the following statement:</p> <p>“People like me because...”</p>

Board Game Role Play: The Dating Game

How many times would you ask out the same person if they keep saying "no".	How would you let someone know (without words) that you are attracted to them?
What is your motivation for learning more about dating?	Role Play: You are at the movies and your date would like to sit near the front - you feel uncomfortable sitting too close.
