What is this body part?

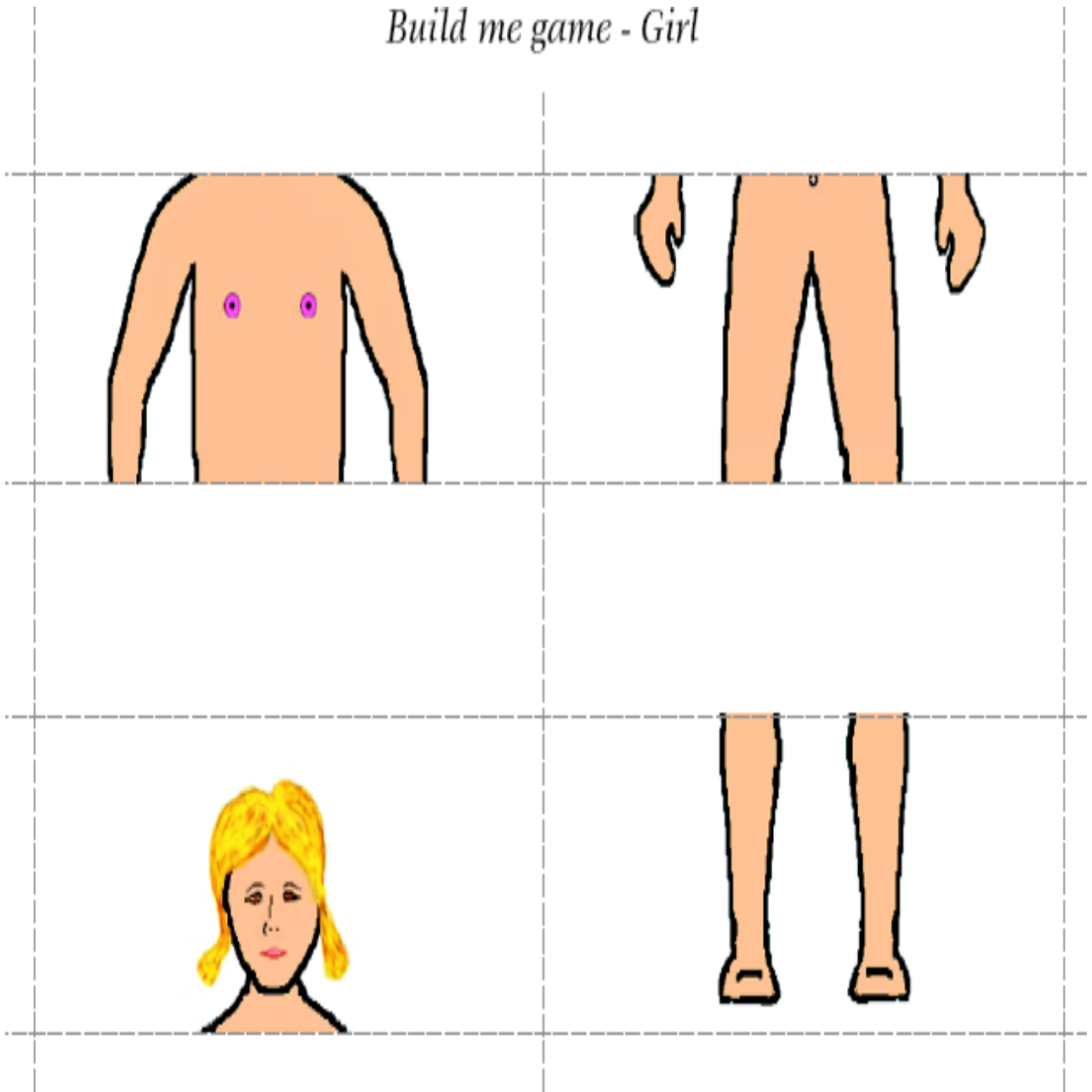
Show me (name of body part)?

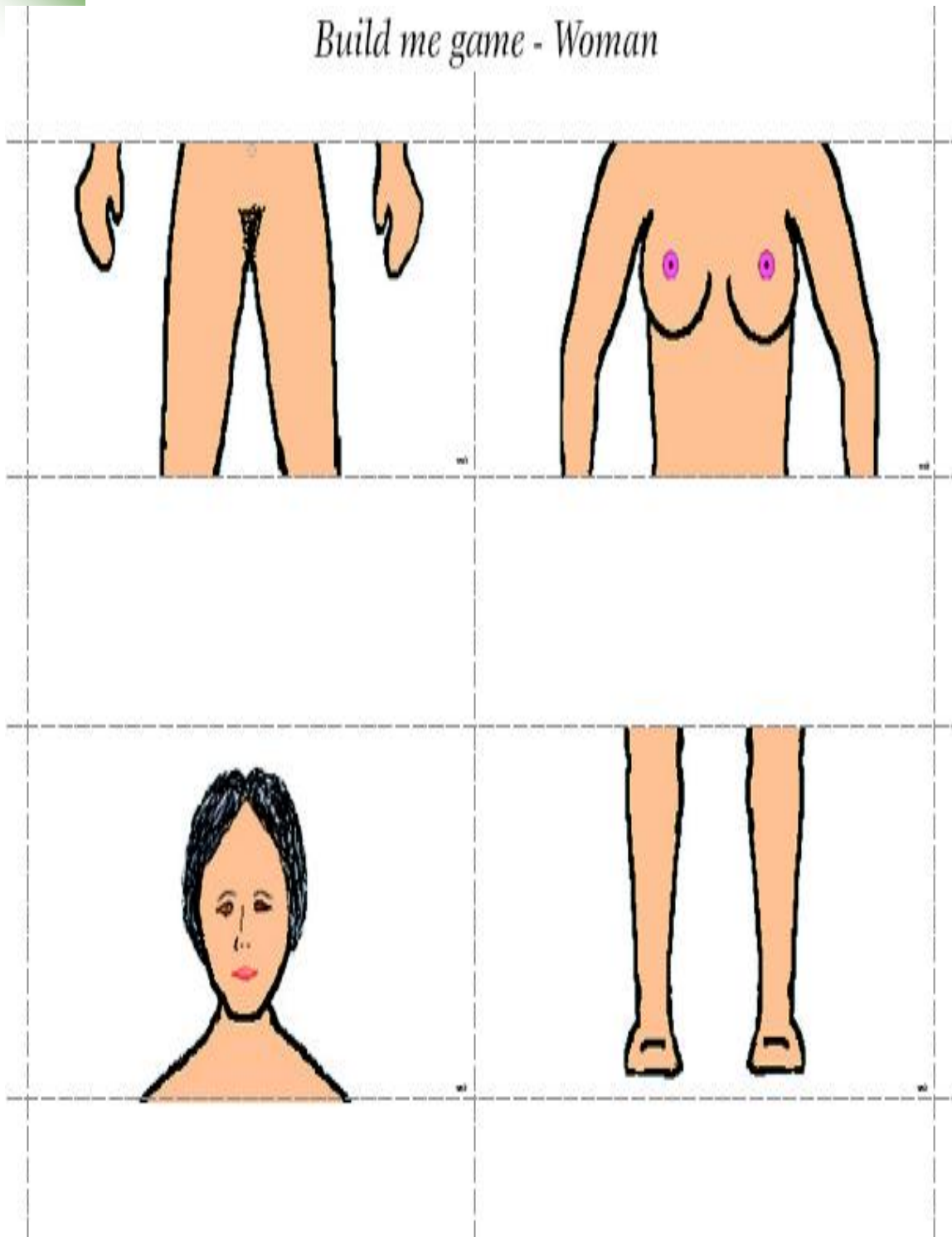
