


Locations and Parking

Appointments and Cancellations

ErinoakKids' Appointment Schedulers are your main contacts for appointments at ErinoakKids. They will call you to book appointments as indicated by your child's clinicians.

If you need to reschedule or cancel an appointment for Clinical Services:

Please call 905-855-2690 or 1-877-374-6625 and press 3, or follow the instructions from your child's clinician. Please leave a detailed message with your child's:

- 1. Name
- 2. Date of birth
- 3. Appointment date and time

If multiple visits are missed without advanced notice, we may need to review your child's service plan. Missing an appointment for a service without calling to cancel could result in your child being discharged from that service.

If you need to reschedule or cancel an appointment for Autism Services:

Please use the ErinoakKids Autism Services absence line by calling 905-855-2690 ext. 2920

Please leave the following information on the voicemail if no one is available to take your call:

- 1. Your name
- 2. Your child's first and last name
- 3. Your clinician's name
- 4. The reason your child is absent

Before your child begins services at ErinoakKids, we require your informed consent. This involves a conversation about available treatment options and your permission to pursue these with your child in accordance with Ontario's Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA).

The personal information that you provide to ErinoakKids as part of this conversation helps ensure that we can provide the best care possible for your child. We will not disclose information without consent. At ErinoakKids, we may collect your personal information:

- to provide care to your child and family
- to contact you about special services and events
- for fundraising purposes
- to meet legal and regulatory requirements
- for statistical purposes.

Preparing for your Appointment

Preparing your child

In preparation for your appointment, we encourage you to speak with your child about what to expect so they feel at ease. Make sure they are well rested, that they enjoyed a meal or snack beforehand and that they are wearing comfortable clothing. Bringing along their favourite toy can help! Don't forget to think about your concerns or any questions you may have. We look forward to meeting you and your child!

What to bring to your appointment

- Any items requested by your clinician, such as food, a preferred toy, communication device, splints or a walker.
- Reports or information from other agencies, hospitals, therapists or doctors that may be helpful to the clinician.
- Your child's health card (for medical appointments or OHIP physiotherapy only).

Assessments

Depending on your concern or the needs of your family, assessments can occur either in a group or individually. Clinicians will use standardized professional tools and criteria to gather information about your child's strengths, areas of need and goals that you would like to focus on

Following any evaluation or assessment, clinicians will make recommendations on course of treatment and connect you with the appropriate supports within ErinoakKids and our community. Some assessments may require a physician referral, please visit **www.erinoakkids.ca** for detailed information.
