

## Help Your Child Communicate... More often

### By Using Good Questions:

Use questions that are open ended. These types of questions give your child time to think, and decide what he/she wants to say. Good questions can:

- Show interest, such as “What next? What if? What now?”
- Allow choices, such as “Do you want \_\_\_ or \_\_\_?”
- Extend thinking, such as “What’s happening? “What do you think? Why?, Who?”

Try to avoid close-ended questions, such as “What’s this? What’s that?”
