Step 7: Pick Up Equipment

Clinicians explain when and where to get your equipment, and how to access ADRS in the future.

Step 6: ADP Funding Application

Complete funding application and figure out your portion of the cost, with help from clinicians.

Step 5: Review the Trial

Meet with clinicians to determine if the equipment helped. If it didn't, discuss what options are available.

Step 4: Trial Period

Try recommended equipment for 4-6 weeks to determine if the equipment meets your child's communication needs. A fee may apply.

Start

Step 1: Parent Only Appointment

Clinicians explain the process, answer questions and gather information about your child to help plan the assessment.

Step 2: Observation Visit

Clinicians observe your child in a natural environment and confirm whether your child is ready to go to Step 3. If your child is not yet ready for full assessment, you will be provided with recommendations and discharged.

Step 3: Full Assessment

Bring your child to ErinoakKids where clinicians will try different equipment and assess which system best meets their needs. This may require multiple visits.
