

# ErinoakKids Seating Clinic

**Stop 1: Select an equipment vendor**  
A clinician will provide you with equipment vendor options for you to choose from.



**Stop 2: Your first visit to the clinic**  
Meet with ErinoakKids clinician(s) and the vendor to assess which device will work best.

**Stop 3: Try it out!**  
You will have the chance to try the equipment at the clinic, at the vendor's store or in your home.

**Stop 4: Decide on your equipment**  
If you're ready to make a decision, then you'll finalize everything with the seating clinic clinician. If you want to try another piece of equipment, go back to **step 3**.

**Stop 5: Create a funding plan**  
An occupational therapist will complete the necessary paperwork and send it for approval, or you may access your own private insurance if available.

**Stop 6: Buy your device**  
Once approval is received from the Ministry of Health's Assistive Devices Program, your child's equipment will be ordered, and you will pay the vendor for your part of the bill.

**Stop 7: Pick up your device**  
Come to the seating clinic to receive and set up your equipment.

**The equipment is yours!**  
Please contact the vendor if your equipment needs any repairs.
