Who we are:

Speech Language Pathologists (SLPs) and Speech Language Therapy Assistants (SLTAs).

What is SBRS Speech Language Therapy?

We are healthcare professionals who may provide speech treatment, recommendations and resources to support students with the skills required to participate in school curriculum.

Who can we help?

Students who require additional support to participate in school and access curriculum in areas of speech including articulation, motor speech, speech fluency/stuttering and/or voice/resonance disorders.

What we do in school:

The ErinoakKids SBRS SLP works with caregivers, students and the school team to identify needs and to help set goals, create an intervention plan and provide strategies to maximize student success. The SBRS SLTA may provide direct treatment and home programming as directed by the SBRS SLP.

Most services take place at the school, however there may be some service options families access virtually or at one of the ErinoakKids sites.

Visit frequency depends on student goals and their specific speech needs. Connect with your SBRS SLP anytime assistance may be required.

SBRS Speech works on these parts of speech:

- Phonology: Patterns of saying sounds that are the same almost all the time.
- Motor Speech: Planning, control, and coordination of speech movements.
- Speech Fluency/Stuttering: Smoothness or forward movement of sounds, words or sentences.
- Voice/Resonance: Quality, pitch, loudness or use of voice.
- Articulation: Accuracy of how sounds are made and used in words and sentences.
