

Early Motor Speech Goals and Words

Motor Speech Movement (Target Goal)	Sample Words in various syllable shapes (VC, CV, CVC, CVCV)	Verbal Cues (given by parent/clinician)
JAW CONTROL Jaw excursion	On, Off, pop, hop, top Hat, Pat, Mat	Big mouth (if jaw is not extended enough) Little mouth (if jaw is too open) Jaw in the middle (if there is jaw sliding)
Lip Rounding (o, oo, w)	GO, boat, no, open, more, pour, hole Pooh, moo, boo-boo Wee, one, wet	Round lips
Independent lip movement from jaw for lip sounds (p, b, m)	Pour, paw, pot, hop Boo, baa, buck, boom Me, more, mat, home	Strong lips
Lip retraction ("ee")	Me, Bee, Eat Yes	Smiley lips
Tongue tip sounds independent from jaw (t, d, n)	Toe, two, eat, mat, pat, put, hat Do, dough, hide No, neigh, one, on	Tip of tongue (tip of tongue touching behind upper teeth) "n" (wind out of nose)
Airflow Sounds (h, f, s)	Hi, home, hide Find, fit, food, off, puff See, same, house, horse,	"h" - Lots of wind, hold out palm of hand and blow air on hand "s" – snake sound – smiley lips and extend airflow out (extend finger down arm) "f" – bottom teeth on lip and blow wind out
**Most difficult Integration of jaw and lips or sequenced movement (involves moving from one movement to the next movement and consonant clusters)	hi, bye, mouse, house, out, down, you sweep, spoon	Cue for both movements (e.g., "i" is big mouth and then smiley lips, "you" – retracting lips followed by rounded lips)
